## DEDICATED ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT EFFORT

Maintaining a professional organization working for Vermilion's success.



- Secured \$63,750 in public funds & \$20,000 commitment for 2020
- Added 3 new, private stakeholders and renewed commitment from 6 existing
- Gave 7 presentations and 24 interviews about projects & services
- Wrote 17 press releases about opportunities or updates for publication
- Worked with local and state officials on 35 parish issues
- Parish rep for Acadiana Economic Development Council, One Acadiana, & LIDEA
- Identified legislatively-created funding mechanisms for evaluation

### **EXISTING BUSINESS ASSISTANCE**

Assisting the existing business community is our #1 concern.

- · Conducted 32 business visits
- Answered 145 inquiries
- Attended 7 ribbon cuttings
- Managed 11 retention projects, 7 of which were new
- Distributed 14 newsletters (events/tips) to 7% larger database with a 26% open rate

- Hosted social media class in partnership with Matthew Aaron Agency for 18 attendees

- Co-hosted a training for 20+ jobseekers in anticipation of annual job fair
- Marketed job openings at 20 local companies/agencies
- Directly assisted 7 jobseekers with their resume and job hunt
- Co-hosted an employer workshop to educate employers on the latest in human resource law
- Co-hosted parishwide job fair with 27 companies and, 3 resource providers, & 92 attendees
- Launched 55 by 25 Initiative with press conference & tour of school system's Jump Start programs
